A. A Simple Guide For Parents To Go Through The Bible Lesson


- a. Find a most suitable time during for about 30 40 minutes.

- e. Read the Bible passage twice.
 - i. First time parents read as dramatically as you can
 - ii. Second time child to read with parental guidance
- f. Summarize the lesson as provided in the lesson outline below. If you have an extra time, you may choose 1-2 questions from the lesson outline below.
- h. Help your child to do the activities below.
- i. End with prayer with your child repeating after you. Depending on the age of your child, keep each phrase as understandable as possible and within 4-5 words. E.g. "Dear God, thank You for the lives that you've given us. Help us to live this life so it can be a blessing for others. In Jesus ' name. Amen."

Questions you may want to ask your child	 What kind of gifts or abilities have we received from God? (e.g. life, etc.) What can I do with the one gift or talent that God has given me? In what ways, can I multiply the gifts or talents from God?


