

A. A Simple Guide For Parents To Go Through The Bible Lesson

- a. Find a most suitable time during for about 30 – 40 minutes.
- b. Have the laptop/iPad and all the necessary materials ready in place.
- c. Begin with a short prayer.
- d. Choose 1 – 2 songs from the music videos to sing.
- e. Before you show the video from the folder, ask your child to look out for “how did Jesus heal the sick person (the son)”?
- f. After your child has answered the above question, read the Bible passage twice.
 - i. First time – parents read as dramatically as you can
 - ii. Second time – child to read with parental guidance
- g. Summarize the lesson as provided in the lesson outline below.
- h. Go through the respective workbook/activity section with your child.
- i. If there is still some more time, have a short Q&A time (you may choose 1 – 2 questions from the lesson outline below).
- j. End with prayer (your child may repeat after you)

Bible Passage	John 4:43-54
Lesson objective	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Children will understand that Jesus has ability to heal sick people2. Children will understand that Jesus will respond when we ask Him3. Children will be able to pray to Jesus and ask for healing or any other problem
Duration	30-40 minutes
Lesson Summary	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Jesus has ability to perform miracles<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Jesus healed people's sicknessb. Jesus healed without even meeting the sick person2. Jesus is responding to our request<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. There were many sick people during that time but Jesus only healed that particular boy because his father was begging for help (see John 4:47)b. Likewise, we can always ask Jesus on behalf of other peoplec. The goal of Jesus responding to the request was so people will have faith in Him (see John 4:48)

What will you do if you are that father whose son was sick?5. Why do you come to Jesus?6. How should we ask Jesus to help us?7. Do you know anyone who may need Jesus' help?
