

A. A Simple Guide For Parents To Go Through The Bible Lesson

- a. Find a most suitable time during for about 30 – 40 minutes.
- b. Have the laptop/iPad and all the necessary materials ready in place.
- c. Begin with a short prayer.
- d. Choose 1 – 2 songs from the music videos to sing.
- e. Before you show the video from the folder, ask your child to look out for:
 - i. How much food was there at first?
 - ii. How did the people feel after they had eaten?
- f. After your child has answered the above questions, read the Bible passage twice.
 - i. First time – parents read as dramatically as you can
 - ii. Second time – child to read with parental guidance
- g. Summarize the lesson as provided in the lesson outline below.
- h. Go to this link (<https://www.wikihow.com/Make-Salt-Dough>) and together with your child form a bread and fish using the salt dough.
- i. If there is still some more time, have a short Q&A time (you may choose 1 – 2 questions from the lesson outline below).
- j. End with prayer (your child may repeat after you).

Bible Passage	Mark 6:30-44 (NIV)
Lesson objective(s)	1. Children will have the confidence to trust Jesus for all their needs.
Duration	30-40 minutes
Lesson Summary	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Jesus understands our needs and has the ability to fulfill them<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Jesus had compassion on His followers (v.34).b. Jesus would not leave His followers hungry (v.35-37).2. We can be confident that Jesus will also care and provide for us<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Jesus solved the problem without any difficulties (v.38-42, 44).b. Jesus satisfied the needs of the people more than they can imagine (v.42-44).
Questions you may want to ask your child or your child may ask you	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. How does it feel to be hungry?2. How much food do you think will be enough for 5000 men plus women and children? What made Jesus able to feed more than 5000 people with only 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish?3. What will you do if in the future you were surrounded by hungry people who have no food to eat?4. What are the things that we really need in our lives that we can ask Jesus to provide?5. What have you learnt about Jesus from the story?
