### Praying against COVID-19

- 1. **For the sick and infected**: God, heal and help. Sustain bodies and spirits. Contain the spread of infection.
- 2. **For our vulnerable populations**: God, protect our elderly and those suffering from chronic disease. Provide for the poor, especially the uninsured.
- 3. **For the young and the strong**: God, give them the necessary caution to keep them from unwittingly spreading this disease. Inspire them to help.
- 4. **For our local governments**: God, help our elected officials as they allocate the necessary resources for combatting this pandemic.
- 5. **For our scientific community**, leading the charge to understand the disease and communicate its gravity: God, give them knowledge, wisdom, and a persuasive voice.

- 11. For families with young children at home for the foreseeable future: God, help mothers and fathers to partner together creatively for the care and flourishing of their children. For single mothers and fathers, grow their networks of support.
- 12. **For pastors and church leaders** faced with the challenges of social distancing: God, help them to creatively imagine how to pastor their congregants and love their cities well.
- 13. **For college and university students**, whose courses of study are changing, whose placements are canceled, whose graduation is uncertain: God, show them that while life is uncertain, their trust is in you.
- 14. **For Christians in every neighborhood**, community, and city: May your Holy Spirit inspire us to pray, to give, to love, to serve, and to proclaim the gospel, that the name of Jesus Christ might be glorified around the world.
- 15. **For frontline health care workers**, thank you for their vocational call to serve us. We also pray: God, keep them safe and healthy. Keep their families safe and healthy.

#### Praying for the Unengaged & Unreached Katang people of Laos

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth" Acts 1:8

POPULATION RELIGION PRIMARY LANGUAGE Spiritism 99.2% Katang Christianity 0.08%

The 67,000 Katang people are dispersed over a wide-spread area of southern Laos. In some of the more remote locations, the Katang live in houses made of braided leaves. In recent decades, however, many Katang have moved down from the hills onto the plains, where they have lost much of their cultural heritage and are on the way to assimilation to Lao culture and language.

Some aspects of Katang culture that are presently under threat includes the traditional Katang longhouse. For centuries extended families of Katang have lived under one roof. When they married, the house would be extended to accommodate the new couple and any children they would later have.

The Katang, both men and women, have for centuries stretched their earlobes and inserted large bamboo tubes in for decoration. This too, is rarely seen among young Katang today.

Although most Katang have absolutely no awareness of the Gospel or the claims of Jesus Christ, there is one Katang church in Laos, with approximately 100 known believers. They have faced great opposition from local authorities, shamans and community leaders, who believe the presence of the Christians will bring a curse on the village from the spirits they have worshipped for countless generations. Most Katang are too bound by fear to consider converting to Christianity.

#### **THANKSGIVING**

Praise God for the one Katang church. Pray for God to bless and anoint this church, rising them up to be a beacon of His light in their community.

#### **PRAYERS**

- As foreigners are not allowed into the Katang villages, pray for God to grant the Katang believers boldness to share Christ with them despite facing opposition.
- Pray for a clear presentation of the gospel truth to the Katang. Pray for the scripture will be translated into their language.
- Pray the Holy Spirit would convict the Katang of sin, that they would boldly turn away from their idols to the one true God, to find freedom and salvation in Christ.

# CLOSING REFLECTION 1 THESSALONIANS 1:2-10

- We give thanks to God always for all of you, constantly mentioning you in our prayers,
- remembering before our God and Father your work of faith and labor of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ.
- <sup>4</sup> For we know, brothers loved by God, that he has chosen you,
- because our gospel came to you not only in word, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction. You know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake.
- <sup>6</sup> And you became imitators of us and of the Lord, for you received the word in much affliction, with the joy of the Holy Spirit,
- so that you became an example to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia.
- For not only has the word of the Lord sounded forth from you in Macedonia and Achaia, but your faith in God has gone forth everywhere, so that we need not say anything.
- For they themselves report concerning us the kind of reception we had among you, and how you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God,
- <sup>10</sup> and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come.

#### **Pray for my Small Group**

(Colossians 3:15-17)

Heavenly Father, please help us to...

- 1. BE AT PEACE "Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts" (v15). This is more than the absence of arguing! Thank God that your small group are all "members of one body", knit together as part of Christ's body (v15). Yet all of us have at some point had mean thoughts, angry attitudes and bitter motives in our hearts, however well we cover them up. Repent before God, and ask that Christ's peace would rule in your heart instead.
- 2. TEACH ONE ANOTHER "Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach ... one another." (v16)
  Pray that during your small-group Bible studies, you would not only learn together, but also revel in the glorious riches of the message of Christ. Thank God that small groups also give an opportunity to learn from the wisdom of people at different life-stages. Pray that all of you would be willing to listen and learn.
- **3. ADMONISH ONE ANOTHER** Small groups should be an environment where Christians can "admonish one another with all wisdom" (v16).

Pray for a group culture of intimacy and honesty; that as you share your lives together, you would hold each other accountable, lovingly point out sin, and earnestly warn one another against wrongdoing. This is hard; but pray you would love one another enough to have these difficult conversations.

- **4. LOVE EACH OTHER...** –... both in "word" and "deed" (v17). Pray that you wouldn't be a group that just meets once a week to talk about the Bible, but a group that truly loves each other with words and deeds at other times too. Then think of a way you can put this prayer point into action!
- 5. BE TRULY THANKFUL See verses 15, 16 and 17! Paul tells the Colossians three times in as many verses to be thankful. So as you think of your small group, think of three things you can be grateful for; then thank God for them!
